#### **GUIDELINES:**

WHEN THE SODEXHO COMPANY IS CHARGING FOR THE ALCOHOL (EITHER TO THE ORGANIZATION/OPEN BAR OR THE INDIVIDUAL PARTICIPANTS/CASH BAR) OR THE SPONSORING ORGANIZATION IS CHARGING THE PARTICIPANTS TO ATTEND THE EVENT:

#### WINE AND BEER

If an event is in a licensed facility (Rathskellar or the 1855 Room) no Special Permit or College Alcohol Permit is needed.

- For college-affiliated organizations:
  - o If the event is in a building with a licensed facility (the Student Center or Eickhoff Hall), then an extension to the license can be obtained by the Sodexho Company for 75.00 and a College Alcohol Permit is required.
- For non-profit organizations holding an event as a fund raiser:
  - o If the event is in a non licensed facility then the sponsoring (affiliated or non-affiliated) organization must apply for a Special Permit for Social Affairs on their own. Additionally, a College Alcohol Permit must be obtained.

# HARD LIQUOR

At all events with hard liquor in any facility or building (including the 1855 Room and the Rathskellar) the sponsoring organization MUST apply for a Special Permit and a College Alcohol Permit.

- WHEN THE GUESTS ARE NOT PAYING TO ATTEND THE EVENT AND THE SPONSORING ORGANIZATION IS NOT SUPPLYING THE ALCOHOL (either beer and wine or hard alcohol):
  - o In the Rathskellar and the 1855 Room, neither a Special Permit for Social Affair, nor a College Alcohol Permit is needed for beer and wine; however, a College Alcohol Permit and a Special Permit for Social Affair is needed for hard liquor.
  - o In any other facility, a College Alcohol Permit and a Special Permit for Social Affair is needed for beer/wine or hard liquor.
- WHEN THE SPONSORING ORGANIZATION IS SUPPLYING THE ALCOHOL (either beer and wine or hard alcohol) AND THE GUESTS ARE NOT PAYING TO ATTEND THE EVENT:
  - o In the Rathskellar and the 1855 Room, neither a Special Permit for Social Affair nor a College Alcohol Permit is needed for beer /wine or hard liquor.
  - In any other facility, only a College Alcohol Permit is needed for beer/wine or hard liquor.

# **SPECIAL NOTES:**

- Special Permits for Social Affairs will not be issued without a diagram of the facility.
- Social Affair Permits will only be issued to non-profit organizations.
- Social Affair Permits, when obtained by the sponsoring organization are \$100.00 per day for Civic, Religious or Educational organizations and \$150.00 per day for all other non-profit groups.
- Applications must be submitted at least three weeks prior to the date of the event.
- A College Alcohol Permit does not require a diagram of the facility.
- The College Alcohol Policy states that all alcoholic beverages MUST BE SERVED BY A SODEXHO BARTENDER.
- The College Alcohol Policy states that no underage guests may be present during an
  event where alcohol is served without special permission from the Vice President of
  Student Life Office.
- THE COLLEGE OF NEW JERSEY IS NOT PERMITTED TO USE STATE/COLLEGE FUNDS TO PAY FOR ALCOHOL. BUDGET & FINANCE WILL NOT REIMBURSE ANY EMPLOYEE OR DEPARTMENT WHO SUBMITS A RECEIPT FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

GENERAL RULE OF THUMB: if there is change of money anytime other than the original purchase of the alcohol at the liquor store there needs to be a license.

#### MORE NOTES TO THE COORDINATORS:

- 1. Sodexho Dining Services at The College of New Jersey has a concessionaire's alcohol license on our campus for two locations. One location is the 1855 Room, and the other is the Rathskellar.
  - a. Our license is limited to the sale of beer and wine only.
  - b. The Sodexho Dining Services can apply for a "Temporary Extension of Premises" permit for any College Related Event.
  - c. Should a College Related organization wish to hold an event with distilled spirits, Sodexho Dining Service should request (in writing) permission to serve the hard liquor for that event only.
  - d. The College of New Jersey is limited to receiving 25 licenses (per location) in a given calendar year.
- 2. There are several scenarios of events which could take place on our campus other than in the licensed facilities. These scenarios are outlined below:

#### **SCENARIO A:**

- Guests do not pay to attend event
- Client provides alcohol (purchased at a retail or wholesale store).

#### PRIVATE ENTITY

- No ABC License Required

#### NON PROFIT – FUNDRAISER

- No ABC License Required

#### NON PROFIT - NON-FUNDRAISER

- No ABC License Required

#### FOR PROFIT

- No ABC License Required

#### COLLEGE RELATED

- No ABC License Required

# **SCENARIO B:**

- Guests do not pay to attend event
- Client does not provide alcohol

#### OR

# <u>Scenario C:</u>

- Guests pay to attend event
- Client provides alcohol (purchased at a retail or wholesale store).

#### OR

# Scenario D:

- Guests pay to attend event
- Client does not provide alcohol

# For either of the scenarios B or C or D, the following applies:

#### PRIVATE ENTITY

- Client must apply for a SOCIAL AFFAIRS Permit with ABC

# NON PROFIT – FUNDRAISER

- Client must apply for a SOCIAL AFFAIRS Permit with ABC. \*\*\*\*

# NON PROFIT – NON-FUNDRAISER

- See For Profit Guidelines.

#### FOR PROFIT

- Client must hire a catering company which has a RETAIL or Plenary Catering License to sell alcohol. (This can be a cash bar or an open bar).

# **COLLEGE RELATED**

- If in a location adjacent to a currently licensed facility, Sodexho must apply for an extension to their Concessionaires license.
- If NOT in a location adjacent to a currently licensed facility, the Client must apply for a SOCIAL AFFAIRS Permit with ABC.

# Note: For all events on campus, a College Alcohol Permit must be obtained.

# NOTE to the Coordinators:

- \*\*\* A Non Profit Organization MUST provide the alcohol to hold an event at The College of New Jersey. ABC will not grant this group a Social Affairs Permit if they do not provide their own alcohol.
- A Non Profit Organization not holding a fundraiser will NOT be permitted to hold their event on The College of New Jersey campus unless they provide their own alcohol.
